

Eaglecrest Snowsports School Policies

Warning

Under Alaska law, the risk of an injury to person or property resulting from any of the inherited dangers and risks or skiing rests with the skier. Inherent dangers and risks of skiing include changing weather conditions; existing and changing snow conditions; bare spots, rocks, stumps and trees; collisions with natural objects, man made objects, or other skiers; variations of terrain; and the failure of skiers to ski within their abilities.

Liability Release Agreement

I understand that there are inherent and other risks involved in the sport of skiing and that injuries are a common and ordinary occurrence of the sport and I freely and voluntarily assume those risks. I hereby release Eaglecrest Ski Area, their officers, directors, employees, agents and assigns from and all claims and liabilities (including costs, attorney's fees, and medical costs) arising out of or in connection with my participation in this activity. If the participant is under 18, the undersigning parents or guardians do hereby agree to indemnify and hold harmless Eaglecrest Ski Area, their officers, directors, employees, agents and assigns from any and all claims and liabilities (including costs, attorney's fees, and medical costs) arising out of or in connection with the participation by the minor child in this activity. As part of ski school instruction and skiing/riding, your child will ride the chairlifts. While on the chairlift your child could be at least 40 feet in the air. Hundreds of thousands of skiers/boarders ride chairlifts every year with no problem, however, accidents do occur. The ski school and/or ski area cannot guarantee that your child will ride the chairlift with any particular person. Your child may ride the lift with a student, instructor, and member of the public or may ride the lift alone. If this is not acceptable, please contact the ski school immediately. By enrolling your child in ski school you understand and agree to have your child ride the lift with another ski school student, a member of the public, with an instructor or alone.

Model Release

I hereby grant Eaglecrest Ski Area, its employees, agents, and assigns the right to photograph myself or my dependent and use the photo and/or other digital reproductions of myself or him/her or other reproductions of myself or his/her likeness for publication processes, including but not limited to electronic, print and/or digital publishing.

Cancellations

Guests who wish to cancel a scheduled lesson or workshop must do so at least 24 hours in advance and receive confirmation of the cancellation from an Eaglecrest Snowsports School Staff member. Any cancellations made within 24 hours of the start of the lesson/program/workshop or any time after will not be eligible for a refund. Cancellations made at least 24 hours in advance are eligible for rescheduling lessons. Those who do not call to cancel and do not show for their scheduled lessons may not be eligible to reschedule.

Make-Ups

There are no make-ups available for missed classes of multi-day programs or workshops which have specified pre-determined dates.

Snowsports School Refunds

Refunds will only be considered for the following: medical reasons or moving out of town (which applies to multi-week/day programs and workshops which have specified program dates only). Refund requests must be made within 2 weeks of the date of a medical situation or move from Juneau area. Requests must be in writing with proof of circumstance (e.g. physician's note) and be submitted for consideration prior to the close of the winter season for which the program/product was purchased. A credit may be granted under certain circumstances. However, a grant of a credit is at the discretion of management.
